A faculty member is a mentor for a group of 10-15 students and monitors them during that

academic year. A student can approach to his/her mentor for any personal or academic

guidance. He/She guides students regarding their performance in curricular or co-curricular

activities, health issues and grievances if any.

Mentors under the guidance of principal provide students solutions of their personal problems

and help them to seek professional advice regarding various issues during their 2 year

programme such as improvement in academics, participation in various curricular and cocurricular activities and any grievances they have. This is done to identify and nurture the hidden talents of students.

The meritorious students are provided with enrichment classes, while remedial classes are conducted for students (slow learners) who need academic support. The mentors identify and take necessary action with regard to students who do not meet the criteria of attendance as outlined under the college norms. Mentor is also responsible for sanctioning maximum 2 leaves to mentees. Their applications are forwarded to the principal in case they need more leave.
